Ms. Clara first started visiting Second Harvest at Morrison Heights while taking another elderly lady to pick up food. She didn't realize how important they would become to her in the following years. The only income that she receives is disability that is less than \$800 a month. She isn't eligible for Social Security because she has never worked outside her home since she stayed home to take care of her sick son. For Ms. Clara the food pantry is more than somewhere to get food, it gives her a chance to socialize with others. Life isn't always easy for her but it's better than where it has been for her, she has roof over her head and a place full of people that genuinely care about her.
